#### **CELEBRATION OF ACHIEVEMENT**

Our Celebration of Achievement evening was held on the 5 December and was a huge success. A wonderful celebration of the outstanding talents, skills and achievements of our students, providing an opportunity for our Mercy community to come together. We listened to feedback from last year and streamlined the event to run under two hours.

#### **CLASS OF 2024**

As you would have read in the Welcome email, the students from the Class of 2024 produced excellent results in their HSC. Some of the highlights:

- The College was ranked 70th in the Sydney Morning Herald's Top 100 Schools List
- > 7 students on the All-Rounders List
- 2 State placings: 9th Food Technology Megan Uy; 9th Ancient History Zoe Borger
- 23 students achieved and ATAR greater than or equal to 95.00
- > 54 students achieved an ATAR greater than or equal to 90.00
- > 78 students on the Distinguished Achievers List (students who scored 90 marks or higher a Band 6 or E4)
- ➤ 193 Band 6 results, the highest number achieved in the College's history
- 3 students selected as part of the HSC Showcase:
  - ArtExpress
  - o CallBack Dance
  - o OnStage Drama

We had a fantastic School Cocktail party last week—thank you to everyone who attended and made it such a wonderful evening!






