Principal's Report

P&F COCKTAIL PARTY

It was lovely to see so many parents enjoying themselves at the P&F Cocktail Party in February. I hope this event will continue to grow and serve as a warm welcome to those new to the OLMC parent community.w

OPEN DAY & ENROLMENTS

Over 1800 visitors came through the College. Such a wonderful celebration of our community. Much thanks to the many parent volunteers we had cooking, serving and cleaning all day.

The new lecture format and longer day assisted in accommodating the large number of visitors on site.

This year was also the first time we open applications on Open Day. Enrolments are strong. At last count, we had 334 enrolments applications for only 220 places in Year 7, 2025. Last Saturday, we conducted interviews with 250 of these families prior to offering places over the coming weeks.

STAFF DEVELOPMENT DAYS

At the end of last year, the staff enjoyed a Spirituality Day on the last day of term, followed by a Staff Development Day on the first day of Term 2. Both days serve to improve the professional skills of our staff while supporting wellbeing and relationships within our community.

BUILDING UPDATE

The Brigid Shelly building is coming along nicely and due to be completed in 2023. We are all anxiously awaiting this as well as the completion of the Francis Kearney lift which should be done well before the end of term. The cost for this lift was well in excess of the expectation because of unforeseen issues under the earth once the piers needed to be set.

I am grateful for the time I spent in Dublin during the break. The Sisters of Mercy organised for myself and 4 other Mercy Principals to visit and stay in Catherine McAuley's House and learn the stories of her life delivered by those who have dedicated their lives to her legacy.

We were blessed with a beautiful sunny day for this year's carnival. It is always a joy to see students and staff in this colourful spectacle.
